RELAY TESTER

Description

The protection systems play a fundamental role in the safety and reliable operation of electrical power systems.

The properly functioning protection devices help maintain system safety and protect assets from damage, which is why the hexa-phase source is an essential testing tool for verifying functionalities before installation.

Equipped with advanced technology and precision components, the device is compact, lightweight, complete, and easy to transport for various protection and selectivity tests.

Benefits:

- Dedicated independent DC power output: It features a dedicated adjustable DC power output of 110V and 220V.
- Comprehensive interface: It has a USB communication port, enabling communication with computers and other external devices.
- Self-protection function: It adopts reliable hardware protection measures, and the software performs self-diagnosis for faults and output locking functions.

Features

- Output up to 6 phases for voltage and 6 for current. It can be arbitrarily combined to obtain voltage of the conventional system (3 phases plus neutral), threephase currents, phases, three-phase voltages, or a combination of both, up to 12 simultaneous channels. They are compatible with traditional output modes. It can perform the differential test of the three-phase transformer and the fast energy reclosing test and automatic reclosing test.
- The equipment ensures the absence of high-frequency interference during on-site tests, guaranteeing a smooth and accurate waveform in all phases of the process, regardless of voltage and current levels.
- The high-performance output part adopts DSP control, which has fast calculation speed, strong real-time digital signal processing capability, wide transmission frequency, and high-resolution D/A conversion control. The output waveform has high precision with a resolution of less than 0.2%, low distortion <1% THDV, and good linearity.

Software

It features a user-friendly and intuitive interface for simple yet comprehensive operation. The test modules are divided into five groups according to different functions:

- General Testing;
- Conventional Protection;
- Line Protection;
- Component Protection;
- Comprehensive Function.

Each group contains several sub-menus. For instance, the "General Testing" group includes five test modules: "AC Test", "DC Test", "Harmonic Overlay", "State Sequence I", and "State Sequence II", which can be expanded arbitrarily.
